PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The City of Overland Park, Kansas retained McClure for the redesign and improvements of the existing Santa Fe Commons and new Thompson Park space in the City's downtown area. McClure was responsible for the coordination of new sidewalks with existing and relocated Evergy power poles and overhead lines within the project area, including curb cuts, sidewalks, and on-street parking in a downtown situation with tight grading tolerances in order to ensure ADA compliance for the surrounding pedestrian sidewalks. McClure worked alongside RDG Planning & Design for the master planning and redesign improvements of Thompson Park.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS:

- McClure was an integral part of the design process and helping ensure any concepts were implementable.
- Managed increases in stormwater runoff, utility connections, and implemented the street improvements.
